

## ***Appendix G: Probable Wildlife Species List***

This list was compiled by Ruth Milner, Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife District Wildlife Biologist as part of a fall 2007 site visit to the Hammons Preserve. The list indicates species that are likely to use the Hammons Preserve for foraging, nesting, or during seasonal migration. Audubon Society volunteers are now visiting the site on a seasonal basis and compiling a list of birds sighted. Recorded sightings of other animals should also be added to the list.
